OVERVIEW OF B.Sc. NURSING COURSE

B.Sc. Nursing is a four-year full-time degree program comprising eight semesters, specified by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) & Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC) and affiliated to Kerala University of Health Sciences, (KUHS), which prepares nursing graduates qualified to practice nursing and midwifery in a variety of settings in either public/ government or private healthcare settings.

1. **Government Quota ***: 30 seats (50 % of total seats) Government seats are those in which the Director of Medical Education makes allotments. Admission to these seats will be made based on merit. Admission process of allotment to Government merit seats (50%) under Payyanur Co-operative Hospital Society – Nursing College will be done by the Director, LBS Centre for Science & Technology, under the supervision of the Director of Medical Education Kerala.. Candidates are requested to visit the official website of the LBS Centre www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in for details.

2. **Management Quota****: 30 seats (50 % of total seats) Other than Government seats (50%), these are the seats against which the Payyanur Co-operative Hospital Society– Nursing College will make allotment. Management seats are those seats set apart for the eligible candidates selected from the applications received against the notification by the management directly based on the merit in qualifying exam. There

will not be any type of reservation in the Management seats. Candidate shall pay the tuition fees and special fees, fixed by the Government. The eligibility for admission is the same as for the Government quota and the candidate will be selected on a merit basis. Candidates can apply online through the college www.pnrcon.com

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1. Academic

a. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala or equivalent examination recognized there to by KUHS, Thrissur with separate minimum pass mark for physics , chemistry, and biology and 50% marks in physics, chemistry, biology in plus two examination put together are only eligible for admission.

b. **Eligibility certificate:** Candidates who have passed their qualifying examination from outside the state of Kerala shall produce the certificate of recognition and equivalency of qualifying examination from the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur. This should be furnished at the time of admission.

2. Age

1. Applicants should have completed 17 years of age as on the 31st December 2026 year. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.
2. Self attested copy of relevant page of school record namely S.S.L.C /ICSE/ CBSE certificate showing date of birth/ copy of birth certificate from appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application in proof of age.

DURATION OF THE COURSE

Duration of the B.Sc. Nursing course shall be four years, which is a credit and semester-based program, comprising of eight semesters including an Internship. The maximum period to complete the B.Sc. Nursing course successfully shall not exceed twice the actual duration of the course (Eight years).

2. The application fee is **Rs.1000/- for all candidates, payable through online**.

4. After entering all necessary information and uploading the mark list, necessary documents, photo, application fee transfer details signature of parent/guardian and applicant, pay the application fee online.
5. Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the candidature.
6. Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances. Incomplete/belated applications will be rejected.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

Selection of candidates will be based on a merit list prepared based on the marks obtained in the plus two or qualifying examination. Candidates should bring all the documents in original for verification at the time of admission. Any false information will lead to cancellation of admission.

a) Preparation of merit list

Marks of Physics, Chemistry and Biology in Plus Two Examination will be considered for the preparation of the merit list. If there is a tie, marks for Biology will be taken, followed by Physics and Chemistry. If all these are equal, Date of Birth of the candidate will be considered ie, with the person of higher age getting preference over the younger. CBSE/ ICSE Senior Secondary Examination marks will be equated with Higher Secondary marks of Kerala syllabus by approved normalization process.

b) Publication of Rank List

The rank lists will be published on the college website www.pnrcon.com on the date notified.

ADMISSION

Selected candidates will be informed the date and time of interview and admission, in due course, through the website. Candidates are requested to visit the website www.pnrcon.com regularly for notifications and announcements. Selected candidates for admission under the Management quota are requested to remit the fee into the college account through bank transfer and must bring the fee transaction details.

COURSE FEE

The fee structure shown below was fixed by the Govt./Fee Regulatory Committee for the 2026-27 admission. Any revision in the fee structure ordered by the competent authorities for the current academic year will have to be paid by the candidate. The annual fee is payable at the beginning of the academic year during each year of the course. Caution Deposit is refundable after the completion of course on submission of Non-Liability Certificate (NLC).

DISCONTINUATION

- A candidate who gets allotment and admission to a course through the Directorate of Medical Education, Kerala for the Academic Year 2026- 27 will be eligible for full refund of fee remitted and he/she need not pay any liquidated damages up to the date fixed by Government.
- Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing College before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1st year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the College at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the College midway, the

right of the management for liquidated damages, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent “Civil Court.”

EXAMINATION

- Regular University Examination is conducted at the end of each semester and supplementary examination as notified by KUHS. Examination fees shall be remitted by the candidate as stipulated by the University & college from time to time.

ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING EXAMINATION

- A candidate must have a minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical in each subject to appear for the University Examination. A minimum of 80% attendance in all the non-exam going subjects in the concerned semester is essential for registering a candidate for the university examination.
- The candidate must secure 50% marks for internal assessment in theory and practical, wherever applicable to be eligible to appear in the university examination of the subject.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students shall strictly observe professional conduct and high standards of discipline.
2. Students should maintain decorum and dignity in the College, Hospital & Hostel.
3. As per clause 7 of the Rules and Regulations of the University and Judgment of Honorable Courts regarding the conduct of students on campus, the management has the right to stall organizational activities of students' organization directly or through their member students in campus. An undertaking to this effect be given by the students and their parents at the time of admission.
4. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the College and Hostel campus. If any incident of ragging occurs, strict action will be taken as per the latest direction of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
5. Use of mobile phones by the students is strictly prohibited in class, clinics and during working hours. If found in use, it will be confiscated.
6. Use of drugs/smoking/alcoholism etc. are strictly prohibited in class/compound/clinics/hostel. Any violation leads to dismissal from the College.
7. Any type of in disciplinary behavior (whistling, passing comments, exhibiting posters, spreading rumors, shouting etc.) towards teachers, other students or staff will not be tolerated and will be subjected to major disciplinary actions.

8. Any change in the contact address / telephone number should be informed to the College immediately. The college will not be responsible for any delay /non-receipt of information /communication due to the address change.
9. The institution shall not be liable for the delay/loss in communication owing to failure of postal / courier service.
10. Each student should report for class / clinical at the specified time. Latecomers will not be allowed to attend classes/clinics.
11. Students should inform class coordinator / concerned teacher about any inability to attend classes and should submit the leave letter in time. Absenteeism from class / clinics without prior information will be marked as double absence along with other disciplinary actions.

UNIFORM

- Students are to follow the dress code strictly in class and clinical areas as specified by the institution.

HOSTEL

- Hostel facilities are available for students. The annual hostel fee may change according to the fluctuations of prices of commodities in the market.
- Admission to the hostel is compulsory for students whose residence is very far from the locality of the college. However local candidates who stay with their families are exempted from hostel stay.
- The whole year Hostel fee should be remitted before the starting of every Academic Year.
- Hostel Policy should abide by all the Hostel's inmates. Students are to follow the dress code strictly hostel campus as specified by the institution.

MESS FACILITY

- Hostel inmates will get a mess facility.
- Mess fees will be collected according to the fluctuations in the prices of commodities in the market.
- The Mess/Canteen dues for the current month will have to be settled before the 5 th day of next month.
